Thanks to Briana for setting up the school Lip Sync competition this term. We are excited to see who and what they showcase in week seven.

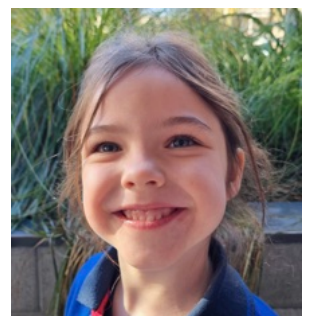
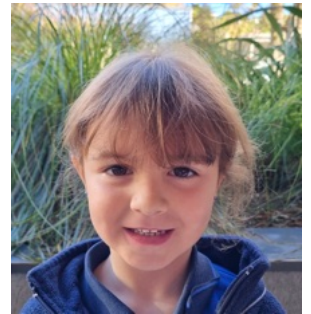

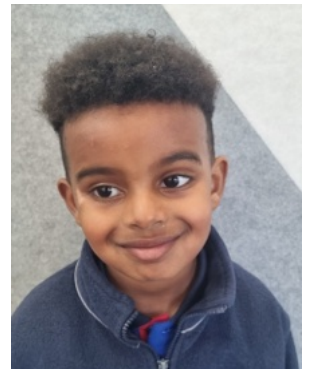


## PB4L SCHOOL FOCUS

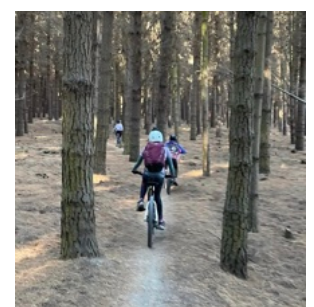
